As some of you may know, I was recently diagnosed with Lyme Disease, which is not uncommon for this area. Both my husband and my daughter have had Lyme, but this is my first personal experience with it. I have learned a few things that I wanted to share with you.

If you have ever had Lyme, you know how intense and pervasive the all-over body aches can be. I have a new appreciation for those who deal with chronic pain like this every single day. If you have chronic pain, like fibromyalgia, I'm so sorry I did not understand before; I do now and I see you.

I have also learned the power that can be found in something so tiny and seemingly insignificant. A tick is one of the smallest creatures, yet can wreak so much havoc, causing not only Lyme disease, but other diseases. Ticks are not the only small and dangerous creature to be aware of; similarly, Covid-19 can spread through aerosolized droplets. A tiny, yet deadly virus. It is important that we remember that just because something is small, does not mean that it cannot be extremely powerful. We do not need to live in fear, but we need to have a healthy respect for the impact such things can have on our lives and the lives of those we love.

Thankfully, there are many good things that come in small packages as well! I have experienced many of you reaching out with offers to help, prayers and healing energy. I am so deeply thankful for your generosity of spirit and kindness of heart. This Tri-County Area is blessed by so many compassionate individuals in the parish!

Even in these times, there are many small things we can do that can have a strong impact: something as small as a smile, wearing your mask, saying a prayer, sending an encouraging word of support, or signing a petition. What may seem small to you, could have greater significance to the recipient.
